1. **Welcome** - meeting was moved to conference room due to late-running scholarship committee meeting in Board Room. Meeting opened at 4:00pm

2. **Discussion of ESTEEM Supplemental Health Curriculum for Grades 5, 7, 8 (2nd Open Meeting) - vote on board recommendation**

The committee decided to take no action on the supplemental curriculum. Campus representatives reported that they didn't feel it was a needed resource at this time. If it becomes apparent that the campuses need materials to address the TEKS, the committee will revisit at that time.

3. **Discussion of Health Curriculum for Grades 6 and 9 courses (2nd Open Meeting) - vote on board recommendation**

The committee unanimously approved of recommending the state adopted text for the 6th grade and 9th grade health classes.

4. **Review Safe Return to School Plan**

Per ESSER III grant requirements, the Safe Return to School Plan must be reviewed every six months at a minimum. Mrs. Norman reported that no new guidance had been issued from TEA. The committee agreed that the plan is good as it is until new guidance is issued.

5. **Hypertrophic Obstructive Cardiomyopathy Screening for Athletes**

Mrs. McElroy shared information about this screening which detects the thickening of heart muscles. Hypertrophic cardiomyopathy is one of the most common genetic cardiovascular diseases and one of the most common causes of sudden cardiac death with athletes. Dr. Taylor, a cardiologist in the area, and his echocardiology technician Mrs. Dunlap have a program to provide screening free to students. The committee agreed that this would be a good program to bring to Grandview as an optional screening for student athletes and band members. Mrs. McElroy will get information from Dr. Taylor and send it to Mrs. Norman so she can share it with the Athletic Director and Head Band Director.

6. **Student Medication Policy**

Nurse Davis shared updated procedures with over-the-counter medications on school campuses. There will be additional information shared with parents in the registration packets at the beginning of the 2022-23 school year.

7. Back to School Fair Update

Mrs. Norman shared that the BTS Fair committee has been very active. Materials have already been purchased and delivered to the elementary. Several organizations have also committed to be at the fair - Carter Blood Care will have a donation bus, ACH Family Services will be sharing information about resources available to families who are raising children of relatives.
