2. School Lunch Program Updates - Lee Ann Breton reported that the School Lunch Program is running well; it's more like normal this year. The supply chain issues are not as prevalent as they were last year. The district food service has a surplus in budget due to last year's special circumstances. This money must be spent on food service, and for now the district is going to wait to see how the budget looks before spending any extra amounts in the spring since food costs have increased. The JH and HS are looking into using a 3-week menu cycle vs. a 4-week cycle for next school year.
3. Back to School Fair Updates - The date for the back to school fair has not been set yet. The committee was asked to be thinking about any new options that we might want to add to the fair. Pam Preston said she would like to have a table for the Cleburne Pregnancy Center to provide information.
4. School Safety Funding - Amy Norman discussed the new School Safety grants that are coming available for school districts. One grant of approximately \$7500 is specifically for a silent alarm system. The district is looking at various options including hard wired systems as well as app systems that can be accessed on cell phones. A second grant of \$200,000 will be available to address other areas of school safety. The state is providing a list of acceptable uses for the funds. If the need to prioritize expenses arises, the SHAC may be asked to provide input on which items on the state list should take precedence.

The meeting adjourned at 4:28pm.
