Scholarship Guidelines and Application

1. All applicants shall be Grandview High School graduating seniors and must have attended school in Grandview ISD in the immediate past three years.
2. All applicants must have been a member of the Grandview FFA and/or Johnson County 4H for a combination of a minimum of three of the four high school years.
3. A parent or guardian of each applicant must be an active, working paid member of the Grandview Ag Youth Booster Club by December 1st of the applicant's junior year and must maintain that membership throughout the applicant's senior year. Active membership must include:
 - a. Attending at least half of the scheduled Booster Club meetings in the applicant's Junior and Senior year
 - b. working and/or providing items for the Johnson County Livestock Show Food Trailer, FFA Banquet, and yearly fundraisers
4. All students who want to apply must complete the attached application and essay prior to the Friday before Spring Break and must have a 2.0 overall GPA. Applications will be available from the high school counselor and should be returned to the high school office.
5. A verification committee comprised of Ag Booster members/officers and high school counselor will verify that each applicant has met all criteria before submitting applications to the Scholarship Panel. A Scholarship Panel comprised of an Ag Booster officer whose child is not applying, an Ag Science teacher from another school and a local professional/business person will select the recipient(s) of the scholarship.
6. Money, if awarded will be paid when the recipient provides the Grandview Ag Youth Booster Club with proof of enrollment in an accredited University, College, Junior College or Trade School. The scholarship money must be used within 2 calendar years from graduation date.
7. Money will be paid directly to the student over 2 semesters after a copy of enrollment had been received. The recipient must carry at least 12 hours per semester and maintain at least a 2.5 GPA. If 2.5 GPA is not maintained, the remainder of the scholarship will be forfeited.
8. The number and amounts of scholarships will be determined each year based on the funds available and qualified applicants. The maximum amount of the scholarship will be \$1000.
