\$1,500.00 scholarships will be given each year.

Eligibility:

- 1. This scholarship is open to any Grandview High School senior, regardless of the student's high school grade point average. Grades are important, however, they are not the most important.**
- 2. Any Grandview High School senior is eligible if they plan to further their education beyond high school, regardless of whether they plan to attend a public or private vocational school, community college, or university.**
- 3. Grandview High School seniors interested in majoring in any career field will be considered.**

Terms of the Scholarship Payments:

- 1. Scholarship recipients will be announced at the Grandview High School graduation ceremony.**
- 2. The first half of the scholarship will be awarded the first fall semester following high school graduation, and the second half will be awarded the first spring semester following high school graduation.**
- 3. Proof of full-time enrollment with at least 12 semester hours (a bill/or receipt and a class schedule) from an institution of higher learning must be presented to receive both scholarship payments.**
- 4. For the first scholarship payment, proof of full-time enrollment must be presented to Brad Grady at Grady Rentals.**
- 5. For the second scholarship payment, proof of enrollment and a transcript (grades) from the fall semester must be presented to Brad Grady at Grady Rentals.**

How the Essay will be evaluated:

- 1. The essay must be typed and must not exceed 250 words.**
- 2. Grammar, spelling, and writing skills will be considered.**
- 3. The content of the essay will weigh heavily in determining the recipients of the scholarships.**
- 4. Scholarship applications and essays must be stapled together.**
