

What did you learn in World Geography?

Assignment Due Date: Friday, May 22nd

Project Goal:

With the extended “work from home” situation, and this being your final “assignment” in World Geography for the school year; I want you to write a brief essay describing **which World Geography skill you have found to be most useful this year**. Give **two reasons** why the skill you choose has been most useful, and how you might use this skill in the future.

Let me give you a few hints of skills we have learned in class: map making skills; learning locations of states, countries, and capitals; learning about physical geography (landforms, climate, water cycle, ecosystems), political/economic geography (types of government and economic systems), human/social geography (religions/cultures); these are just a few skills that we developed this year. You can pick from this list or come up with your own ideas.

Your assignment is to write a paper describing the most useful World Geography skill you have learned this year, and how you will use this skill in the future. Give two reasons for each.

Project Supplies:

Project Instructions:

1. Take some time to think about the most useful World Geography skill you have learned this year in class.
2. Use a bubble map to brainstorm ideas on how to answer the following questions.
 - a. Describe the World Geography skill.
 - b. Why do you find this skill useful?
 - c. How do you think you will use this skill in the future?
3. Write an essay detailing the most useful World Geography skill you learned this year, and why it is useful now and how you will use the skill in the future.
